MESSAGE FROM FATHER BROWN

Springtime and early Summer always seems to have an energetic atmosphere about it, especially in regions like ours with its seasonal changes in the weather. Our calendar of worship expresses excitement too as the Easter/Ascension period of over forty days is enhanced even further by the Solemnities of Pentecost, Holy Trinity, and the Body/Blood of the Lord (aka, *Corpus Christi*). These three days highlight elements of our faith which are so much a part of our belief, spirituality, and worship that we might take them for granted; so, the church's calendar highlights them intentionally.

Last week-end, the Feast of Pentecost reminded us of the many gifts, talents, and diverse personalities that make up the People of God. The Holy Spirit is the dynamic Power which quickens and motivates our effort to be the best that we can be, to bring our many parts into the one Body of Christ, living in our world today. Since 2018, Pope Francis has encouraged us to add a dimension to our reflection on Pentecost. It is certainly not new that we recognize the presence of Mary of Nazareth in the circle of those who received the Holy Spirit at the Cenacle in Jerusalem; nor is it new that we call her by the title “Mother of the Church.” What is new is that there is special Mass celebrated in her honor on the Monday following Pentecost; for us, that Mass happens on Wednesday 29 May, at Saint Ambrose.

Today's Solemnity, the second of the Post-Ascension trio, highlights an element of our faith which is perhaps the most frequently articulated as it is repeated so often since our typical prayer is in the Names of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The dimension of the life of the Trinity which must not be overlooked, however, is that the three distinct Persons, each with a separate personality, are bound together by Love. The Love of the Father, Son, and Spirit for each other is the heavenly model for how all earthly life should be, within families, within nations, within the planet, within the cosmos.

And, as these lines are being composed on Monday, 20 May, we will nonetheless note that this week-end is one of great community fellowship and celebration. I will have much more to say about this once-in-a-lifetime event, in which you graciously place me at the center. But for now, suffice it to say that I am honored and humbled by your gracious presence. Welcome and Thanks to you all.
